FISCAL ANALYSIS

ASSUMPTION

Officials from the **Department of Higher Education** assume no fiscal impact to their organization.

Officials from the **University of Missouri**, the **Extension Council of Buchanan County**, and **Missouri Western State College**, in response to a prior version of this proposal, assumed no fiscal impact to their organizations.

Oversight assumes the property is worth approximately \$35,000 based on an unofficial estimate from the county assessor's office. The property has not been formally appraised since it has been state-owned for decades. The proposal provides for consideration as negotiated between the parties, which the parties understood to mean no financial compensation. Because there would be no revenue to state funds or expenditures from state funds, **Oversight** has not shown a fiscal impact to the state.
