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FISCAL ANALYSIS

ASSUMPTION

Officials from the **Department of Revenue** assume:

The Safari Club International has approximately 800 members in Missouri. If it is assumed that 5% of those are members will apply for this speciality plate it would only be 40 applications. This would have a minimal impact on the Department of Revenue and could be implemented with existing resources.

The revenue generated from the additional \$15 fee would also have minimal impact based on the number of applications anticipated. If the number of applications increased, revenue would be affected accordingly.

Officials from the **Department of Transportation** concur with the Department of Revenue response.
