ASSUMPTION

Officials from the **Department of Public Safety - Missouri Highway Patrol**, **Department of Social Services**, **Office of Prosecution Services**, **Office of the State Public Defender**, **Office of the Attorney General**, **Department of Mental Health** and the **Office of the State Courts Administrator** each assume this proposal would not fiscally impact their respective agencies.

DESCRIPTION

This proposal clarifies that any offender to whom the registration requirements apply (Megan's Law), must register with law enforcement by September 10, 2002, or within 10 days of being released from custody or becoming a resident of any county.

This legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
