\$1,395 x 75% = (\$1,046) Highway

Oversight assumes the fiscal impact of this proposal would be minimal and could be absorbed from existing resources.

#**Oversight** also assumes the number of plates to be issued, and the revenues and costs associated with this proposal would be minimal and could be absorbed from existing resources. If the volume of new special license plates exceeds anticipated levels, additional funding could be requested through the existing budget process.

Officials from the **Department of Highway and Transportation** were unable to provide an estimate for this proposal. Therefore they must rely upon the DOR's response.

Officials from the **Missouri Veterans Commission** and the **Missouri Highway Patrol** assume this proposal will not have an impact on their agency.

No direct fiscal impact to small businesses would be expected as a result of this proposal.


DESCRIPTION

This proposal would allow those who serve in Operation Enduring Freedom to receive a special license denoting such service. This proposal would also revise the process for the registration of historic motor vehicle plates. Owners of vehicles with plates consistent with the year of manufacture would be allowed to register and keep those plates.

This legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
