DESCRIPTION

This act authorize the Recorder of Deeds in the City of St. Louis to be named the local registrar for birth and death records. Currently, Section 193.065, RSMo, allows the State Registrar to appoint local registrars if they are employed by county health agencies. This act allows an exception for the City of St. Louis by allowing the State Registrar to appoint the Recorder of Deeds for the City of St. Louis as the Local Registrar for that city.

This legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
