### FISCAL IMPACT - Small Business

No direct fiscal impact to small businesses would be expected as a result of this proposal.

#### **DESCRIPTION**

This act limits the state's allowable fee for processing adoption documents to \$100 per child, per visit or per multiple children adopted at the same time. Current law allows a fee of \$10 per document.

This legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
