DESCRIPTION

This act provides that the Secretary of State would not be allowed to collect fees for processing apostilles, certifications, and authentications prior to the placement of a child for adoption in excess of \$100 per child, per adoption, or per multiple childern to be adopted at the same time.

This legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
