Every year my office sends each member of the General Assembly a list of individuals and entities within their district who have Unclaimed Property. Please be on the lookout for a separate email with that information.

As State Treasurer it is my responsibility to return as much of Missouri's \$1 billion of Unclaimed Property as possible to its lawful owners, and I am asking for your help with that.


A review of the Unclaimed Property database indicates I am currently holding \$57,892,938.43 belonging to approximately 480,215 owners in your district.

There are several ways you can help us get your constituents their money:

- During public events and through your own direct outreach, you can encourage people in your district to search for and claim their property free of charge on ShowMeMoney.com. Our office can also mail paper claim forms to your constituents upon their request.
- You can also encourage your office staff to reach out to constituents on the above-mentioned list.
- Use social media and word of mouth to direct your constituents to the unclaimed property lists which will be published in newspapers across the state in June. Constituents may also find information regarding Unclaimed Property on the State Treasurer's [Facebook](#) and [X](#) pages.

I look forward to working with you to ensure constituents in your district are able to claim their Unclaimed Property.
